Section 3635 of the New York State Education Law provides for the school districts to transport elementary and high school children to private and parochial schools. Children of school age in New York State may attend when the schools in question meets health, safety and educational requirements of the Commissioner of Education and the State of New York. Transportation will be provided by the Board of Education of the Middleburgh Central School District to all resident children who legally attend approved non-public schools. A child must have reached his/her fifth birthday on or before December 1st in order to be eligible for transportation. Mileage is measured from the pupils' home to the school they legally attend. Transportation for parochial school is to the nearest parochial of the particular denomination.

All request for transportation of resident children to non-public schools are due in the office of the Board of Education of the Middleburgh Central School District no later than April 1 of the school year immediately proceeding the school year in which the transportation is be initiated.
