CAMP SESSION OPTIONS

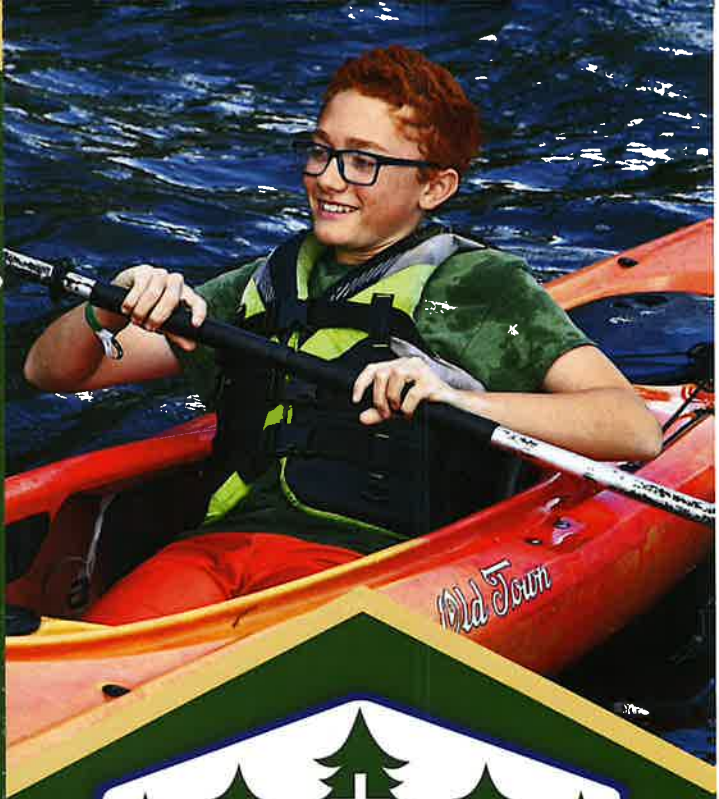
Each camping session is 6 days, 5 nights and welcomes approximately 190 children. Please visit our website for exact dates.

ABOUT LONG POINT CAMP

ACCOMMODATIONS

Children sleep in large cabins that accommodate twelve campers, two counselors, and one support staff member in each unit. Cabins are equipped with indoor toilets, showers, and recreation rooms for rainy-day activities.



HEALTH CARE

Long Point Camp operates a health center 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to provide appropriate and necessary care for children and staff. All care is approved by a physician and the New York State Health Department. When additional care is needed, the local doctor's office and hospital are available.



SUPERVISION

Children will be supervised by counselors and program staff at all times. Staff members are carefully screened and required to complete an orientation and training program prior to the start of the camping season.



CANTEEN

Parents may send money with the campers to purchase a variety of camp merchandise: camp shirts, blankets, stuffed animals, etc.



ACTIVITIES

Camp activities include swimming, low ropes course, arts & crafts, fishing, canteen, evening programs, hiking, outdoor living/camping, kayaking, music, sports and recreation, archery, and other activities.



Because we are a Christian camp, children will also be encouraged to participate in Christian education, devotions, prayers and a worship service.

Who: Children ages 6-12

When: **YOUTH** (ages 6-12) Monday, July 28 through Friday, August 1

Deadline for all forms to be submitted: Friday, July 7, 2025

YOUTH (ages 6-12) Monday, August 4 through Friday, August 8

Deadline for all forms to be submitted: Monday, July 14th

Cost: No cost to campers and their families in Service Unit communities.

How: Must use Google Chrome or Firefox. Applications are completed online: www.longpointcamp.org. A completed application and all forms are required. A doctor's physical is required within 13 months of attending camp (school physicals can **NOT** be accepted). **Doctor must complete our physical form.** All forms must be completed by the deadlines listed above. Transportation may be provided for specific camp sessions for some areas. Parents may self-transport their children to and from camp for either session.

LONG POINT CAMP APPLICATION-WHAT TO HAVE READY WHEN YOU APPLY:

Welcome parents and helpers! Thank you for applying to Long Point Camp!

Here are some tips of what to have ready before you get started with our online camper application:

DOCUMENTS:

- Health Insurance cards
- List of the child's medication by names and dosages
- All your physician's names, addresses and phone numbers
- List of your child's major illnesses if applicable (ie-measles, pox, etc) & dates
- Your SNAP/TANF benefit number if you have this program
- List of emergency contacts (names and phone numbers)-you'll need two not including you

Here are some things to keep in mind and plan for as you get ready for camp:

- Any medications (if any) listed by the doctor will be required at camp. If there are meds not taken during the summer, please check to make sure the doctor doesn't list them on the Physician's Exam form. If listed by doctor, will need a note from doctor stating they do not take it in summer.
- We are not able to enroll your child to attend camp until the application and all forms are completed and approved after review. You'll get an email from us after your child has been enrolled.
- The camperships are on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the slots are filled, we can only place your child on a waiting list. We generally get twice as many apps as we have slots available. The sooner you start and finish your application the better your chance of getting a spot for camp.
 - If you cannot go to camp after you've been enrolled-PLEASE contact us right away so we can give a child from the waiting list an opportunity to go. Call or text Amy Brodock at 315-877-6079.
- Some areas may have transportation to and from camp. Or, you may transport your child to camp for the sessions that are available in your area.
- If your household has (or you suspect) headlice or bedbugs, a fever or foot fungus, please do not send your child to camp. We do not have a means to clear your child of these problems and would have to send them home, which may create a bad experience for the child.



Every Kid Should Go to Camp!

Sign your child up today by following the steps below:

Step 1: Visit Longpointcamp.org/enroll

Step 2: Select “New Camper Enrollment”

*(Unless you have previously used campminder for The Salvation Army and have your login information- select “Login to Camper Profile”)

Step 3: Input Parent/Guardian Information

Step 4: Create a Password- Record your password here for your records:

Step 5: Select a Session “2025”

Step 6: Enter the Child’s (Camper) Information

Step 7: Select the Sending Unit “Service Unit”

Step 8: Select the Session (the one circled below) as the one your child will be attending:

Time Travel 2.0 – July 28-August 1 (Ages 6-12)

Superhero Camp- August 4-8 (Ages 6-12)

Step 9: You will continue through the application filling out all parts of the application.

Step 10: Once you complete the online application, your child will be in our system, but the process is not finished. **To complete your registration, the following forms must be completed for each camper:**

- Camper Photo
- Physician's Examination Form
- Health History Form
- Immunization Form
- Parent Authorization Form
- SFSP Application
- Photo Release
- Camper Behavior Contract: Camper Agreement
- Camper Behavior Contract: Parent Agreement
